

VIRGINIA

BHE GT&S is an interstate natural gas transmission and storage company with operations in 10 states and total assets of 5,400 miles of pipeline and 420 billion cubic feet (bcf) of working storage. Through operational company Eastern Gas Transmission and Storage (EGTS), its system links to other pipeline markets in the Midwest, Mid-Atlantic and Northeast. It provides reliable energy for large customers, including power generators and local distribution companies.

In Virginia, the company operates about 75 miles of transmission pipeline and has four compressor stations, and houses the headquarters in Glen Allen, just minutes from the state capital, Richmond.

The company has nearly 300 employees in Virginia, including those operating four compressor stations in Leesburg, Loudoun, Pleasant Valley and Quantico with a total of about 135,850 horsepower.

OPERATIONAL EXCELLENCE

EGTS is frequently recognized for its outstanding safety record, including awards from the American Gas Association (AGA) as the Industry Leader in Accident Prevention. EGTS closed 2022 with its best year on record for OSHA recordable injuries and, in 2023, EGTS went 226 consecutive days without an OSHA recordable.

REGULATORY INTEGRITY

The company's pipeline and storage systems are regulated by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC), the Pipeline Hazardous Material Safety Administration (PHMSA) and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

CUSTOMER SERVICE

In 2023, EGTS ranked fourth overall among 37 other pipelines in the customer satisfaction category in a survey compiled by Mastio & Company. It also ranked second in the survey's Mega category, which groups together the largest pipelines that the study examines.
